Invitation for the participants

Dear students,

The International Summer School is an opportunity to meet colleagues from other countries and to delve deeper into a specific topic. You are invited to the Summer School in Ljubljana, where we will be exploring the topic of **Bioethics and Education**. It is becoming increasingly clear that (bio)ethical topics need to be taught early enough. Bioethics is not just a subject for medical students; we need to sensitise secondary school students to the topic. Recently, several projects have been launched to teach bioethics in secondary schools.

Our summer school will focus on the content and methods of teaching bioethics in secondary schools. The topic is of interest to educators, philosophers, theologians, lawyers and other students. In addition to lectures and workshops at the Faculty of Theology in the centre of Ljubljana, we will spend one day at a school on the outskirts of Ljubljana, which has approximately 1500 pupils. One day will be dedicated to learning in nature. We will visit the magical karst cave of *Škocjan Caves* (UNESCO World Heritage) and the Adriatic coast with *Strunjske soline* (salt pans), where we will be able to observe unspoilt nature. There will also be plenty of opportunities for socialising and exchanges.

The cost of the summer school is 200 € and will be fully covered by a grant provided by CEEPUS. Meals will be provided; bus transport and entrance fees will be covered.

Accommodation will also be provided by CEEPUS. However, you will not receive an extra scholarship from the CEEPUS-office.

You are welcome to join us in Ljubljana **from 15 to 20 April 2024**. If you wish, you can come as early as 14 April. Register in the CEEPUS app by the end of October. We look forward to meeting you.
